their generosity in helping us reach our team entry fee of **\$3,000**.

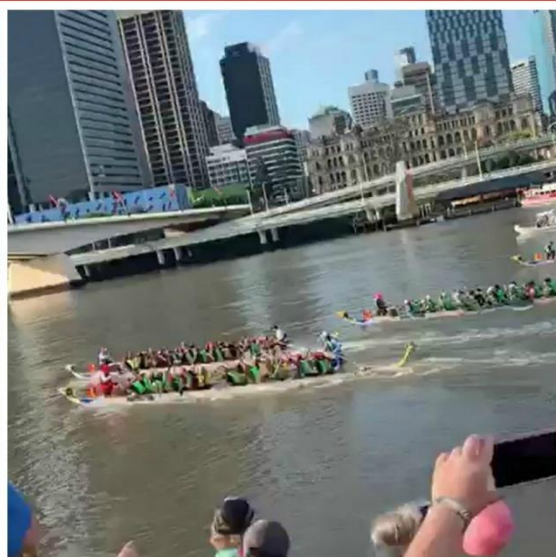
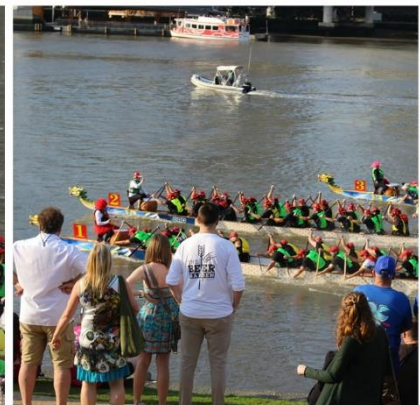
TOM & KAYLENE McGRATH for giving up their time for the 3rd year to drive our safety boat at the event.
