Jenny apologised that the details will be 'off the cuff' as the report has been misplaced.

The Club wasn't fully functional due to Covid but was able to maintain a good financial position. In our general account we have \$17,762.00 and in our building fund account (% out of our membership) - sinking fund account to maintain the building - is approximately \$7,700. We have another account with approximately \$13,000 in which we deposit money received when we hire out our boats to DBQ, with these funds used to maintain the boats. We also have money received from the last Grant \$11,270 to be used to epoxy the floor. Also, is the money in a holding account from members who have paid a key deposit - which will be refunded to the member when the key is returned.

Financially, we did reasonably well eventhough we didn't hold our regatta. We continued to receive funds from the Container for Change. We also received \$400 from MBRC for each Come n Try that we held. Our membership fees for 2020/21 were only charged for a six month period.

Rita B had a query asking why the Council did not maintain the building. It was confirmed that the Council would maintain the building eg if the roof was damaged but any additional improvements eg resurfacing the floor was at the Club's expense.
